- 75 youth participated in our Reading Literacy Summer Program.
- 40 youth participated in our Spring Break college tour week.
- 17 Youth Participated in "LOVE NOTES" a healthy relationship cohort through the Kent School of Social Work.

**EMPOWER...**

- 10 Youth were selected to go to Atlanta Georgia to compete in a case competition focused on twitter.
